COVID 19 IN SIERRA LEONE. March 31 was the day in which the index case was announced in Sierra Leone. Today June 29, 2020, the total cumulative case is 1450 and recovery is 961 with 60 deaths so far. Kabala, where we are, has 7 confirmed Cases, three of them recovering, including one of our church members. Thank God for her recovery. We continue to hold services in our various homes

MONGOL WORK: We give thanks to God for the progress of the work in the Mongol Falaba district. Being a new district there are a lot of opportunities, as well as challenges. We have decided that we will use the old radio transmitter that we were using in Kabala to start a new branch of Radio Shalom in Mongol. With this development we hope to reach out a wide audience.
