This position assumes full responsibility for providing complex case management for the Home Share service including liaising within complex care dynamics, problem solving and crisis management. You will be based in Abbotsford with some travel within the lower mainland required. This is a full-time position, available in March 2021. It is ideal for an experienced leader who has worked directly with people who have disabilities.
