WILLOUGBY CHURCH COVID 19 GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING IN-PERSON WORSHIP SERVICES

1. You must register online in order to attend in-person worship services

2. Before you arrive you must complete the BC COVID 19 Self Assessment. Do not attend if you are feeling unwell, coughing, sneezing, have a temperature, etc. Do not attend if you have had contact with someone in the past two weeks who may have COVID-19 or had contact with someone who has been in contact with others who have or are suspected of having the virus.

3. Be sure to wash your hands prior to leaving the washroom, if used.

4. Hand sanitizing is mandatory on entry into the church. Sanitizer is provided.

5. Maintain the appropriate physical distance guidelines of **6 feet/2 metres apart**. You will be seated in a scattered fashion throughout the Sanctuary, with pews in-between households.

6. Masks are mandatory unless needed to be removed for the purposes of eating and drinking.

7. Singing is not permitted, other than by the vocalist(s). You are encouraged to listen, to reflect, to hum along if you like, and to use this space as a more contemplative time for worship.

8. There is SONLiFE for children ages 3 – Grade 2 to a maximum of 20 children. Children will be directed upstairs. Public Health protocols for children will be followed.

9. An offering basket is available at the door if you wish to bring your tithes to the service.

10. Outside doors will be open, and fans will be on to facilitate air flow.

11. Upon exiting do not congregate in the lobby, or outside the exit doors, or in the parking lot.
