

COUNCIL NOTES

FROM THE MAY 2023 COUNCIL MEETING

Council discussed:

- chapter eleven and twelve of Pursuing God's Will Together by Ruth Haley Barton.
- church visiting. We welcomed Pastor Chris DeWinter of Immanuel CRC, Langley to speak to us about the why and how of church visiting. Classis BCSE has appointed Immanuel CRC to be our church visitor and we look forward to how they will use their gifts to serve us in this role.
- We did not receive the Federal Summer Student Grant. We are continuing to explore options.
- an upcoming council orientation and training conference that is planned by five CRC churches, including Willoughby. The training date is set for September 16, 2023.
- the summer preaching schedule. We noted that May 28 will be the last Sunday that Bert Slofstra will preach, and a potluck lunch is planned so that congregants can thank him for his work with us.
- The Annual General Meeting will be scheduled for Monday June 19, 2023.

Council approved/accepted/appointed:

- the reports submitted by the Daycare Committee, Staff, Worship Team, Finance Team, Building & Grounds, Pastoral Elders, and Deacons.
- the request by the deacons to change their term of service from 3 to 4 years, to keep in line with the council and pastoral elders.
- the request by the Finance Committee to fund Ladies Reconnect for \$1600 to cover the cost of 4 events per year.
- the request by staff to ask Rev. Ray Aldred to preach on October 1, 2023, the Sunday following Truth and Reconciliation Day.
- The request by Building and Grounds to remove some pews in the sanctuary to provide more leg room.
- The request by Rhys MacCarthy to withdraw his membership for Willoughby CRC.

- A good introduction to and visit with Pastor Chris DeWinter.
